Sustainability data is now widely available across the capital markets. The Uses of ESG Workshop Series presents case studies highlighting the nuances of utilizing this information in investment processes and decision-making.

INSIGHTS INTO CORPORATE REPORTING

The IFRS Sustainability Alliance uncovers best-in-class sustainability and integrated reporting efforts through a variety of member outreach efforts. To date, the SASB Alliance has conducted the **Corporate Investor Dialogue**, an opportunity for corporate reporting entities to present their sustainability reports and receive direct feedback from investor members. Similarly, the <IR> Business Network has offered the **Report Critique**, a project for members to receive expert analysis of integrated reports. These initiatives will continue through 2022 and then evolve to meet corporate members' needs moving forward. The **Corporate Implementation Special Interest Group** will enable organizations to share best practices and discuss solutions to reporting challenges among peer members.
